In compliance with ISO 14001 Section 4.4.7 and all applicable federal, state, and local regulatory requirements, Top Management must develop and maintain the required emergency preparedness and response plans. The plans need to describe how to prevent and mitigate the environmental impacts that may be associated with them.</i></li><li data-bbox="146 1270 1347 1333"><i>2. When the required emergency preparedness and response plans are approved and finalized, EMS Representative and the EMS Coordinator will implement the plans' requirements.</i></li><li data-bbox="146 1354 1429 1417"><i>3. The EMS Representative and the EMS Coordinator will review, test, and update the required emergency preparedness and response plans once a year.</i></li></ol>
